## Sigmund Snopek III Plans Concert at Miramar Theatre

Clarinetist Christopher Zello will perform the Milwaukee premier of "Towers, Effigies and Spirits." Both Sander and Zello are familiar names in the Wisconsin classical music community, performing regularly with local and regional ensembles and orchestras.

To round out the evening, Snopek will play a series of piano compositions, selected from his recent CD, "Jade."

A reception in the theatre lobby will follow the performance.
